These documents are designed so they can be printed or used in your favorite notetaking app such as Notability, Goodnotes, Samsung Notes, etc. I personally use the Samsung Notes app because it's my favorite. That particular app is free to use for anyone with a Samsung device or a Windows 10 or 11 operating system. Another one that a lot of people use is XODO. They have a basic plan for free. If you have a Samsung Device or Windows operating system, I highly recommend Samsung Notes. It has a great way of organizing and I've been using it for years. I'd even pay for it! But don't tell them because I don't want them to start charging. Just kidding, but seriously I do love the system.

For digital use, you just need an app where you can annotate a PDF document such as those listed above. The process is simple. Simply choose the document you want then import it right into your notes app.

As for printing, in my personal opinion as well as most designers, Adobe Acrobat Reader is hands down the best PDF reader out there. It's been around the longest and it's free from the Adobe website. **Also Important to know: When printing from a PDF reader, be sure to select the page you want to print or you will print the entire file. Some PDF documents have more than one page.**

Note: Notice that the website has all templates (printables) in US Letter Size and A4. Use what is best for you.

Since this was designed as a printable as well, and there are no hyperlinks to worry about, just import the entire document into your notes app, then delete the pages you don't want and rearrange them how you like them.
